Finance Update: January - May 2019

Earlier in the year we raised some concerns about the finances of the church. Namely that we had finished the past two years with a deficit of around £20k per year.

We presented a budget that would see us end 2019 in a break-even position and allow us to maintain our current levels of support to important causes such as Baptist Missions/Youth/Women, etc.

We have been hugely encouraged by the response. At the end of May we budgeted to have a surplus of £1.6k. The reality is, that we are sitting with a year to date surplus of £24.3k.

Three things are driving this:

- The amounts received in the April Gift Day far exceeded our hope & expectations. We budgeted for £13.7k as that was what was required to plug our shortfall. We received £27.4k net of Gift Aid rebate:
- We have received a Legacy donation which was not budgeted for, and:
- We have made savings versus budget on expenditure.

If this continues, it will allow us at year end to:

- Support causes, such as the various departments of the Baptist Association. to the same levels as prior years, and:
- Pay a substantial amount of capital off our building loan.
